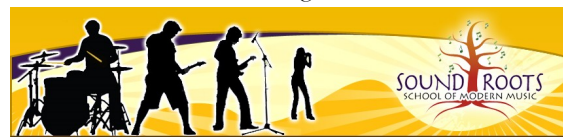

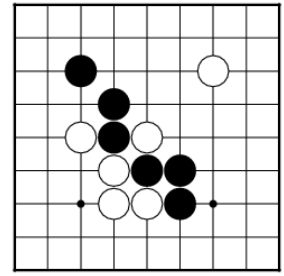
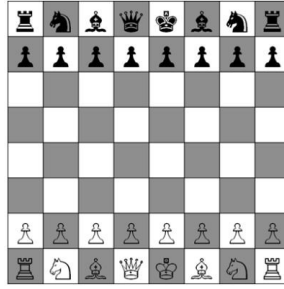

This year we have a new teacher for the Chess and Go Club at Irvington. His name is Fritz Balwit. Fritz has been a well known chess teacher in Portland for almost ten years, leading chess clubs at several Portland Public Schools, Montessori schools, Waldorf etc. He has coached the Winterhaven Chess team to tournament success many times. He has also run chess camps, given private lessons, and presented chess simultaneous exhibitions. He has a high expert ranking in chess. Fritz also teaches Go and offers free Go to the public at two locations weekly including Tabor Space youth Go on Sundays which is open to all student go players in the area. Fritz was awarded the American Go Foundations "Go Teacher of the Year Award" in 2011 for his work with Portland youth, In both Games he strives inspire kids with the endless possibilities of creativity, the ideals of sportsmanship, fair-play and respect for mastery, concentration, courage and self-improvement. Above all he aims to make chess/go class fun!

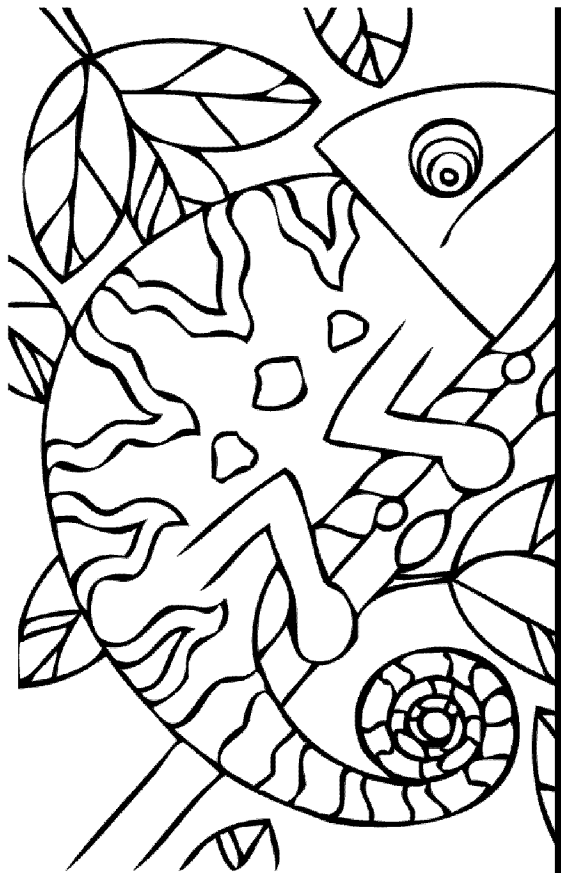
